Key Responsibilities of the Role

- > To prepare the play area i.e. putting out chairs, tables, toys, crafts
- Checking the safety of the rooms and equipment before use,
- > To prepare and serve drinks and snacks, and to wash up the crockery after use.
- To help with craft or musical activities for the children
- > To pack up and put away all equipment after use and ensure the building is left tidy.
- > To talk to the children and their carers
- To listen to any concerns the children or carers may have.
- Responsible for reporting any concerns they have about the wellbeing of the children to the safeguarding officer.
